PROPERTY TAXES

If you have not yet paid your 2019 Autauga County Property Taxes please be aware that any unpaid taxes after December 31st, 2019, are DELINQUENT. Payments can no longer be made online. However you can make a debit or credit card payment by calling us at 334-358-6750 through May 22, 2020. All other payments must be CERTIFIED FUNDS or CASH. Our drop box is located in the front of the Administered Building which can be used or you may call our office at 334-358-6750 to make an appointment to pay.

TAX SALE - May 28, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
