NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Autauga County Commission pursuant to the powers and jurisdiction granted by Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-24-1 et seq., hereby sets a policy to exercise the power and authority to review, approve, and disapprove plats for all subdivisions within the subdivision jurisdiction of Autauga County, Alabama, and that it hereby exercises the authority to inspect any development within its subdivision jurisdiction to ensure that there are no violations of its rules and regulations, to charge fees for said inspection as set out in Section 1-3 of these regulations and authorized under Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-24-3, and to enforce these regulations as provided in Section 1-4 and authorized in Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-24-3.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Autauga County Commission, these regulations shall be enforced and applicable to the development of all subdivisions in the subdivision jurisdiction of the Autauga County Commission from and after the date this resolution. Subdivision regulations previously in place in Autauga County are hereby repealed and rescinded.
