RESOLUTION #2024-18 JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR AUTAUGA AND ELMORE COUNTY, ALABAMA

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission (Commission) is required by <u>Code of Alabama</u> §22-27-47 to submit an updated ten-year Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) to demonstrate effective management with regard to solid waste generation, collection, transportation, disposal, recycling, composting and illegal dumping within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission and Elmore County Commission have determined a joint, multicounty plan would serve our needs in a more efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held in Autauga County on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, at 5:00pm at 135 N. Court Street, Suite B, Prattville, Alabama and in Elmore County at 5:00pm on Monday, March 11, 2024, in the Administrative Complex located at 100 E. Commerce Street, Wetumpka, AL; and
