

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-34

AUTAUGA COUNTY COMMISSION RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE JOINT APPLICATION FOR THE FY 2023 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission (County) is committed to improving transportation safety through reducing the risk of fatal and serious injury crashes on its roadways; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2020, the County partnered with 10 additional Alabama counties, the Alabama Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration, and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc aimed at developing Local Road Safety Plans (LRSP) for Alabama Counties modeled after an initial LRSP developed for Elmore County as part of a pilot program coordinated with similar entities listed above; and

WHEREAS, the County has utilized the current Local Road Safety Plan since 2021; and

WHEREAS, the current Local Road Safety Plan assists the County with identifying and prioritizing locations within Autauga County that could benefit from implementing safety countermeasures to reduce the risk of fatal and serious injury crashes; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to improve and expand upon the current Local Road Safety Plan by developing a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 24112 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Pub. L. 117-58, November 15, 2021; also referred to as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law" or "BIL") authorized and appropriated \$1 Billion in federal funds to be awarded by the US Department of Transportation (DOT) for FY 2023 for the Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the SS4A grant program is to improve roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through safety action plan development and refinement and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the program provides funding to develop the tools to help strengthen a community's approach to roadway safety and save lives; and

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WHEREAS, the DOT strongly encourages SS4A grant applications that involve multijurisdictional partnerships between Counties; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to join and participate in a joint application with the Chambers County Commission, Elmore County Commission and Perry County Commission (Partnership) to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for each county in the partnership; and that the County understands and agrees to the following:

- 1) The expected cost to provide a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan is \$200,000 per county; and
- That the federal share of a SS4A grant may not exceed 80 percent of total eligible activity costs (approximately \$160,000); and
- That the County agrees to contribute a local matching share of no less than 20 percent of eligible activity costs (approximately \$40,000); and
- 4) That applications must be submitted by 5:00 pm edt on Monday, July 10, 2023; and
- 5) That the Partnership must identify a "lead applicant" as the primary point of contact for the grant application to serve as the administrator of the grant application and resulting grant funds; and
- That the expected announcement of the awarded applications will occur between October and December of 2023; and
- That DOT expects to obligate SS4A award funding via a signed agreement within 12 months after awards have been announced; and
- 8) That, if awarded the SS4A grant, the County agrees to provide the local matching share to the lead applicant prior to the execution of the agreement with DOT; and
- 9) That the County is only responsible for the local matching share to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for Autauga County and is not responsible of the local matching share for the remaining counties within the partnership; and
- 10) That this resolution, once adopted by the County, shall serve as its agreement with all other counties participating in the joint application.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTAUGA COUNTY COMMISSION that it agrees to all terms and conditions of the partnership with the Chambers, Elmore and Perry County Commissions as set out above, and desires to participate in the joint application for a SS4A grant.
