RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 12	
WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission remains in the process of developing new recreational facilities on County owned property off of County Road 104 with development to include two multi-purpose ball fields for baseball and softball play; and	
WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission was eligible to make application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) to the Land and Water Conservation (LWCF) Program for 2019 grant assistance; and	
WHEREAS, National Park Service (NPS) delayed the State's funding until such time as Alabama's State Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP) was approved by NPS; and	
WHEREAS, with the SCORP finally approved, the Autauga County Commission has been requested by the LWCF Recreation and Conservation Programs Specialist of ADECA to update and submit documents related to the 2019 application so it may be submitted to NPS for final funding consideration; and	
WHEREAS, said program is limited to funding a maximum of 50% of proposed project costs on a cost reimbursable basis up to a \$500,000 grant maximum; and	
WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission intends to make application for a total project cost in the amount of \$1,020,000 for construction of the proposed ball fields which will include all necessary elements of play and adequate ADA compliant parking and walkways to and from the fields; and	
WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission hereby commits necessary matching funds of \$520,000 in cash and in-kind match as required by the LWCF Program for said proposed improvements.	
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Autauga County Commission as follows:	
<u>SECTION 1</u> . That the Autauga County Commission hereby authorizes the Chairman to submit such required documentation related to the application on behalf of the County to the LWCF program for the aforementioned proposed project.	
<u>SECTION 2</u> . That, the Autauga County Commission commits \$520,000 in cash and in-kind match toward the proposed project, if granted final approval by National Park Service.	
SECTION 3. That in the event a grant is awarded, the Autauga County Commission understands and authorizes Chairman Jay Thompson, to sign all agreements and assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations associated with this LWCF project.
